# Common Sense on Council

## Taxes

- Voted against increasing your taxes over 40 times
- 2nd lowest property taxes among major cities on the prairies
- Senior's Tax Deferral Program implemented in 2012

## Roads & Sidewalks

- Strong advocate to improve the quality of our roads & sidewalks
- Spending improved from \$4.5 Million in 2010 to over \$59 Million in 2016
- 233 km of roadwork in Saskatoon this year alone

## Police, Crime and Safety

- Almost doubled police budget from \$42.7 Million in 2005 to \$84.3 Million in 2016
- Crime rates in Saskatoon continue to drop

## Finances

- 6 balanced budgets in 6 years
- Maintained AAA credit rating

## Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Invested \$8 Million to reduce odour by 76%
- Construction underway – to be completed in 2017

## North Bridge

- In 2012 I campaigned for a north bridge to alleviate traffic congestion
- The North Commuter Parkway Bridge is under construction and opening in 2018

## Transparent & Accountable

- Initiated "recorded votes" on Council so residents can see how their elected officials vote on each issue
- Distributed "Ward 5 Update" brochures regularly to each home
- Accessible in person, and by phone, email, Facebook and website
